



## Black Fleece by Brooks Brothers

In Spring 2007, Black Fleece by Brooks Brothers was introduced as a capsule collection for both men and women to add a new dimension of innovation and style into the iconic 192 year-old American brand.

In creating the earthy aromatic style for Black Fleece by Brooks Brothers for Men, perfumer Vincent Schaller of Firmenich used innovative perfume technologies to impart a contemporary sense of style.

Drawing from Black Fleece by Brooks Brothers' guest designer, Thom Browne's modern approach, Schaller's bright sparkling citrus and fresh spices invigorate, while hints of geranium bourbon and rosewood heart warm the fragrance and blend seamlessly. Rich undertones of patchouli, incense and vetiver complete the scent with a tailored elegance.

Within a quirky, complex yet opulent fragrance structure, Fragrance Resources perfumer, Steve DeMarcado captured the true individuality, intelligence and eccentricity that represent the Black Fleece woman.

DeMarcado defined the fragrance by infusing amber crystals, molten incense and precious agarwood that is modernized with an edgy twist of gilded citron and Asian star jasmine. The resulting brilliant blend of rich woods and incense wraps the woman who wears it in an aura of refined luxury and sophisticated sensuality.

Phronesis have the ability to excite, inspire and affect people in a way that few bands are able to. Since the release of their second album *Green Delay* in 2009, Phronesis, led by Jasper Høiby, the group's double-bassist, have captured the hearts and minds of British audiences and built up a reputation as one of the most imposing trios in the UK.

In 2010 the group has gained more popularity in Europe, with acclaimed performances at the Banlieues Bleues festival in Paris, and the Copenhagen and North Sea Jazz Festivals. Whilst back in the UK, the trio were nominated for the Best Jazz Ensemble in the Parliamentary Jazz Awards in April, featured on the front cover of *Jazzwise Magazine* in August. Jon Newey, the *Jazzwise's* Editor, described Phronesis as 'the most exciting and imaginative piano trio since EST'.
